Amends: Willing and Able

Eight years - that's how long it took to cross off the final name on my original amends list. Rewind to Halloween in October 1998. There I was, drunken, destroyed by a sudden loss, vowing that as long as I lived I could never forgive. Within nine months, I had joined AA and was knee deep in the solution. For the first three years, this person was on my amends list as a "not yet/someday", because I was totally unwilling to make any amends to her. During years four to seven, I had become willing but my sponsor told me I wasn't ready yet. In 2007, as I prepared to travel to Ohio for Founder's Day, this time my sponsor said, "You're ready." It just so happens that when I showed up at this person's door, she was hitting bottom having just totaled her SUV the weekend before in what happened to be her fourth DUI since I'd last seen her. Never in all my imaginings did I ever figure my amends would be a 12 Step call.

On my way back from the amends, I stopped by the Chapel at St. Thomas Hospital where I had done my 3rd Step many years ago, knelt down at a pew and wept. All these years, I thought that an apology for my accusations was the solution. Only God knew the best way to make amends for what happened. You see, I was her friend and we both suffered the loss, yet I took her brokenness and broke her some more. In my anguish, I accused her of a heinous act and discarded her from my life. In the simplicity and quietness of a 12 Step visit, I was given the grace to be her friend, talk about our loss, embrace her brokenness, and be there in the midst of her bottom.

As a result of that experience, my understanding of willingness expanded and I stopped worrying about how I could ever be able to fix the terrible messes I continue to make. I know that as long as I stay sober and keep growing in sobriety, everything can be amended. I am willing and God is able.

The Road to Recovery Group in Osteen

In keeping with our custom of publishing a group history when one is submitted to the Archives we present the "Road to Recovery Group of Osteen." We are delighted to feature a group from the Westside.

The Road to Recovery Group-Osteen was founded on January 3, 2005 by Paul M. to meet at the Good Shepherd Lutheran Church on Howland Boulevard in Deltona. Paul M. was the chairperson at the first meeting. The meetings are held on Monday at 6:30 pm. This time was chosen to avoid conflict with the 8:00 pm meeting in Orange City so that members could make both meetings if they wished.

In the beginning, attendance was between 15 and 17 people with only 7 regular members of the group. Paul M. also served as the first treasurer, coffee maker and secretary. Jan M. was GSR. As in other groups starting with a small membership, members will take more than one service position until the group gets established and membership increases. In July of 2007, Ed R. took over as coffee maker and treasurer. The position of secretary rotated through several group members and Eric is presently serving in this position.

It soon became evident that the church was expanding its programs and there was less room available for the AA group meeting there. Chuck C. helped find a new meeting place and the group moved to the Osteen Methodist Church on Carpenter Avenue in Osteen on March 2, 2005 where it currently meets at 6:30 pm on Monday evenings.

By remaining politically and socially neutral, we avoid alienating those we are supposed to help. When we come under criticism, we can rely on the steps and try not to react to provocation, defensiveness or aggression. As always, unity is key - the greatest good for the greatest number. On a personal level, when I back off, think, pray and meditate, my Higher Power reveals an entirely new spin on a situation. It takes two to argue.
